



Employment Opportunities – Official Raceday Judges (Northern Rivers & Mid-North Coast)

Racing NSW is the representative body appointed for leadership and regulation of thoroughbred horse racing throughout NSW.

Racing NSW is inviting applications for Official Raceday Judge.

There are two positions available. One within the Northern Rivers Racing Association (NRRA) which services racecourses between Murwillumbah and Coffs Harbour and the other within the Mid-North Coast Racing Association (MNCRA) which services racecourses between Kempsey and Foster-Tuncurry.

The primary responsibility of the Official Race-Day Judge is to identify and record each horse's finishing position in a race and provide such information, in an accurate and in a timely manner, to the greater public. These responsibilities are aided with the use of a photo finish camera and associated technology.

The successful applicants will possess the following skills:

- High standard of integrity
- Attention to detail
- Sound memory and concentration
- Ability to work well under pressure
- Ability to work both independently and as part of a team
- Computer and internet literacy
- Valid driver's licence

The Official Raceday Judge is a casual position that requires, on average, two days service a week within each region. Such commitments being on irregular days, including weekends, at varying racecourses within each jurisdiction.

As such the successful applicants will require flexible personal commitments to accommodate the role.

As this is an integrity-based role, any potential applicant will be required to disclose any conflict of interest, perceived or otherwise, with industry participants. The successful applicants will undergo a probity check.
