

INQUIRY INTO LICENSED STABLEHAND MR LEN HOLDSWORTH'S ALLEGED CONDUCT TOWARDS RACEHORSE ANNUAL AT QUEANBEYAN RACECOURSE ON 17<sup>TH</sup> JANUARY 2022

Racing NSW Stewards today conducted an inquiry into a report provided by Racing NSW Investigators in relation to licensed stablehand Mr Len Holdsworth's alleged conduct towards racehorse Annual at the Queanbeyan race meeting on 17<sup>th</sup> January 2022.

Evidence was taken from Mr Holdsworth and Stewards also considered a brief of evidence provided by Racing NSW Investigators, which included video footage of the alleged incident.

Mr Holdsworth was charged with the following offence under the Australian Rules of Racing

### Charge: AR228(b) - Conduct detrimental to the interest of racing

As a licensed stablehand, Mr L. Holdsworth did engage in improper conduct at the Queanbeyan Racecourse on the 17<sup>th</sup> January 2022, by striking the racehorse Annual on or around the rear of the horse with a lead rope, whilst attempting to place Annual into its raceday tie-up stall.

Plea: Guilty

Penalty: \$2000, reduced to \$1500 for guilty plea, with \$750 suspended for a period of 12 months.

When determining penalty, Stewards believed the appropriate penalty for the offence was a fine of \$2000. In regards to Mr Holdsworth's guilty plea and other mitigating factors, Stewards reduced the fine to \$1500 and acting under the provisions of AR283(5) suspended \$750 of the fine on the basis that Mr Holdsworth does not breach any similar conduct related rule for a period of twelve (12) months.

#### **Penalty**

The Stewards considered the following matters when determining an appropriate penalty.

- 1. Mr Holdsworth's guilty plea
- 2. His personal circumstances
- 3. Forthright evidence at inquiry
- 4. Mr Holdsworth's disciplinary history

Mr Holdsworth was advised of his rights of appeal.

# Relevant Rules

# AR 228 Conduct detrimental to the interests of racing

A person must not engage in:

(b) misconduct, improper conduct or unseemly behaviour;

# AR 283 Penalties

(5) Any person or body authorised by the Rules to penalise a person may in respect of any penalty imposed in relation to the conduct of a person and other than in relation to a period of disqualification or a warning off, suspend the operation of that penalty either wholly or in part for a period not exceeding 2 years, on terms they think fit.
